

We are a non-profit organization, who's goal it is to host and participate in multiple events each year to raise funds to benefit those in need.

The Fire Hogs maintain a National Board of volunteers and a membership of over 250 strong with 5-Chapters within the USA. Throughout the year, each Fire Hog Chapter puts on memorial events focused on raising funds to support their local charities. Other Fire Hog events include the Hogs Breath BBQ and Motorcycle Rodeo in October which draws 150-200 participants, Solvang ride, Lockwood Valley ride, our National Rally and St Patrick's Day Parade, and the Julian Ride. In addition to fund raising events, the Fire Hogs participate in the IAFF Memorial ceremonies in Colorado Springs, Sturgis Motorcycle Rally, Laughlin River Run, Arizona Bike Week, and other major motorcycle rallies. In Oct of 2002 the Fire Hogs made a journey coast to coast to honor the 343 FDNY firefighters that were lost just a year before, within that group of Fire Hogs were 4 that had responded to the tragic event as part of the search efforts. In 2026, to mark the 25-year anniversary of the tragedy, over 40 members will make the coast-to-coast journey again to honor the fallen. We will also be celebrating the 250 year anniversary of our Nation during this ride, collecting money to donate to the FDNY's fallen along the way.
